- Application of Safety Instrumented Systems;
- Inherently Safer Processes;
- Expert-Based Systems to Manage Chemical Reactivity Hazards;
- Case Histories and Lessons Learned.

### Scope

Papers are solicited on relevant topics. Papers on innovative approaches to process safety in the chemical, oil & gas, mining, construction, manufacturing, pharmaceutical, pulp and paper, steel and other process industries are invited. Papers with a cross-disciplinary approach and with general application are especially invited.

This symposium will be included in the WCCE8 proceedings. However, we encourage the submission of the full articles to Process Safety Progress, the Canadian Journal of Chemical Engineering or Canadian Chemical News.

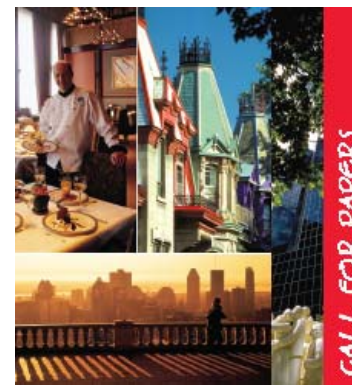
